Parking Plea

Sadly, since opening both school sites to all children in September we have had several reports from residents and parents walking to school about cars being parked across driveways, on the double yellow lines in Trinity Road and up on the pavement on Chobham Road. It can make it extremely difficult for families walking along pavements on their way to school and could potentially be extremely dangerous if they and their children have to walk into the road to go around parked cars.

Free parking is available in the mornings and afternoons at Sussex Road Recreation Ground, alternatively you could use the Vyne Car Park on Redding Way or Sainsbury's Brookwood. Please could we ask that all parents and carers park only on the school side of Chobham Road. The school has good relationships with the local community, which we are keen to maintain, please ensure cars are parked considerately at all times.
