Please note – due to current Surrey COVID updates, we will continue to risk assess the event up to the day of performance. This could mean that last minute changes could be made. Currently, cancelling the performances will be a last resort as we feel that these experiences are very important for our children.

Year 2 Nativity Performances:

After much careful consideration and due to a number of new COVID-19 cases this week, we feel that we have to take further action to protect our school community. Consequently, we have to make some changes to the Year 2 Nativity performances.

We feel it is very important to go ahead with these performance, but with some key changes.

Each class will still perform on their allocated day, but this will now be a revised version of the play that will be located outside in the Woodland Enclave area. This performance will include the songs from the Nativity, but not the acting parts. The children will dress in their costumes and will perform the songs as a whole year group. As well as the live singing, we will also provide a recorded version of the full nativity for parents and guardians to view, via the Google Classrooms.

For our live performance, we ask:

- We do still ask for only two visitors per child
- Face coverings are worn unless medically exempt
