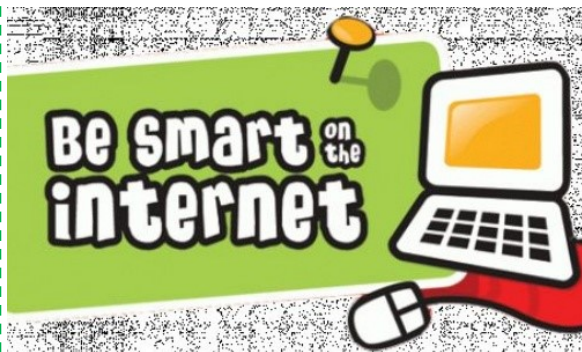


Weekly Update : Knaphill Junior School
