Assemblies the week:

We used a new key text this week, After the Fall by Dad Santat. This book helps us to understand what happens to Humpty Dumpty after he famously fell from the wall. We used the book to explore the importance of growth mindset and bravery, whilst exploring when we may have let fear get in our way.



We have come to understand that fear is a very normal feeling, which often keeps us safe,

however it can also make things tricky. Several children showed confidence in sharing their experiences of fear: Daisy talked about her fear of reaching the top of climbing wall, Paige talked about swimming for the first time and Florence shared how she has battled her fear to conquer our school monkey bars.

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



What's happening at Knaphill Lower School this year?
