Assemblies the week: Children's Mental Health Week : As Mrs Wood shared with you previously, this week was Children's Mental Health Week, and was based on making meaningful connections. "Human beings thrive in communities, and this connection is vital for our wellbeing." Many of us will know this first-hand ,after our shared experiences during the pandemic, we have realised

that connections and relationships are more important that ever before. This week, our children have developed their understanding of: Need to Talk Boxes (which give our children a way to seek adult support and are present in all classrooms), benefitted from the re-introduction of 'Snack and Chat' at playtime (which gives children to opportunities to build connections with each other); and have begun to learn how to use mindful massage as a proactive mental health strategy.
