Be kind – this rule focuses on the relationships we have with each other. We should be kind with our words and actions. We also encourage you to go above and beyond for each other.

Be safe – this is about taking responsibility for staying safe in school. We want children to consider how to keep themselves and others safe in all situations.

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to be taking part in Waste Week, along with schools from across the UK and overseas. This year the focus is food waste. Did you know that the amount of edible food wasted in the UK could fill eight Wembley Stadiums? Or that we throw away 20 million slices of bread EVERY day in the UK, which creates greenhouse gas emissions equivalent to over 140,000 cars every year? Or 1.4 millions bananas are thrown away every day in the UK? Our aim is raise awareness of this and educate our children and the community to reduce unnecessary food waste.





We have been very lucky to work closely with local supermarkets (Sainsbury's and Tesco) who kindly agree to donate bananas that otherwise could have been wasted.
