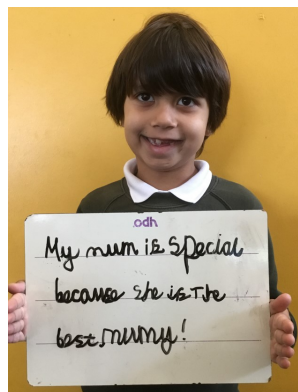
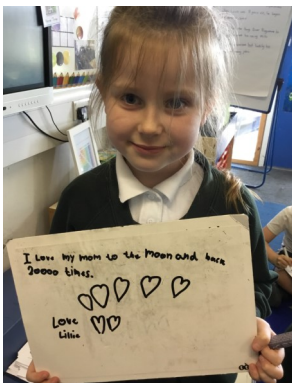


A word from Miss Harbridge:

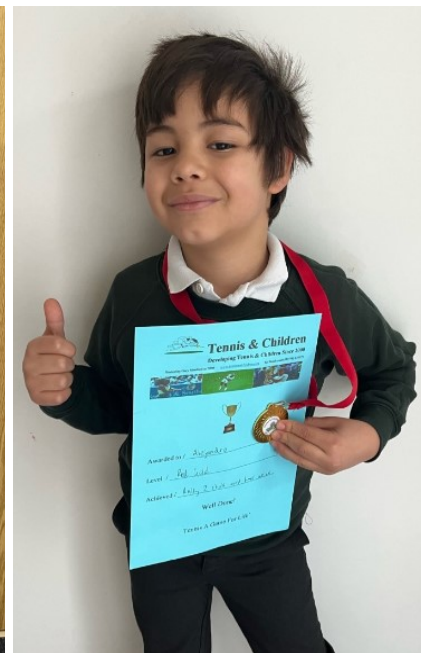
Florence has been awarded a 'high merit' in her ballet exam that she completed in December. **Thank you for telling me all about it and keep up the hard work!**
