## A word from Mrs Harrison:

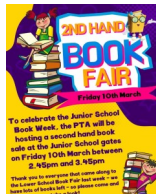
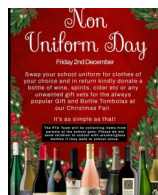

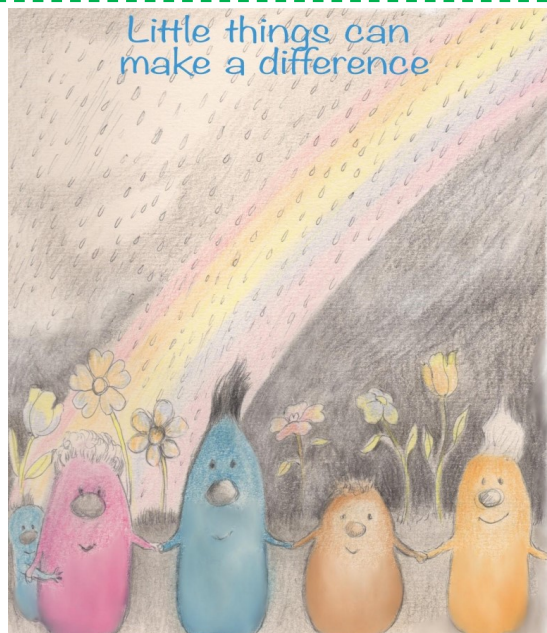
The winners for this term were **Farah** who will have a Non-Uniform day in the first week of September!
